The scholarship is up to \$4,000 to be distributed over the 4 semesters of the program. She had a rich career practicing medical-surgical, obstetric and gerontology nursing in her home state of West Virginia before continuing her education in graduate nursing. To be eligible for the Catherine Relihan Scholarship, candidates must:

- be admitted to the MSN MAGELIN program
- have an admission cumulative GPA or pre-requisite GPA of at least 3.4/4.0
- submit an application
- submit an essay describing your aspirations for personal and professional development in the program

If chosen, candidates will be invited to be interviewed by a selection committee.
