Admission Requirements

1. A completed Graduate Admission Application.
(Apply online at www.msj.edu/apply)
2. A 3.0 cumulative GPA for MBA foundational courses, verified by a completed MBA Foundational Course form.
3. An undergraduate cumulative GPA of 2.75. Students with a 3.0 GPA receive "direct admission" to the MBA program.
4. Submission of a one-page, typed statement of the applicant's career goals in the next five years and how a MBA will help you in achieving your goals (waived for Mount students with a 3.0 GPA or higher).
5. Names and contact information of 2 references (waived for Mount students with a 3.0 GPA or higher).
6. Successful completion of an interview with the MBA selection committee.
