The scholarship is \$5,000 to be distributed over the 4 semesters of the program. She had a rich career practicing medical-surgical, obstetric and gerontology nursing in her home state of West Virginia before continuing her education in graduate nursing. - have an admission cumulative GPA of at least 3.4
- submit an application
